Format of Play:

Preliminary rounds robin system after that in a knock-out system.

The competition is a (3) bowls pairs in a format of round-robin in the first round. All nine ends of the two sets should be played to complete the game. Two points will be awarded for a set win and one point for a tie. An additional 2 points will also be awarded to the team with the most aggregate shots after the two sets. If the aggregate shots are tied, each team will be awarded 1 point. The team with the highest score would win the game of each group and enter to the Final. During the Final an additional three ends will be played when the set are tied.

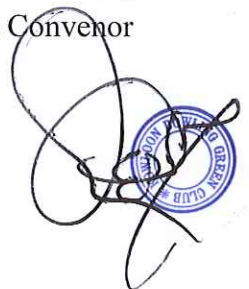
- Round 1: 13th August 2017 (Sun.) at 10:00am

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. HK\$500 per team as deposit – make cheque payable to Kowloon Bowling Green Club.
All deposits are refundable at the end of the competition but if a team fails to complete all games, deposit of the team will be forfeited and no points will be counted.
2. Please ensure that the dates stipulated are adhered to by playing the games on or before the deadline, otherwise we will unfortunately be required to give walkovers.
3. Substitute is permitted.
4. All stipulations will be the same as National Games. In case of green closed or inclement weather, games will be postponed to the next week.
5. Reservations for bowling rinks will be applied on a first-come -first-served basis.
Bowlers are required to mark their reservation in the Bowls Dairy placed at the Main Bar.
6. Winner must notify result to KBGC General Office after the game.
7. Final date and time will be decided by the Bowls and Asst. Bowls Convenor.

KBGC International Bowls Classic Pairs Qualify Match 2017

Rules and Format of Play

BC / ABC shall have the right to alter or amend the programme of the event as it shall consider necessary or desirable, in view of unfavourable weather or other adverse conditions, and may suspend play temporarily in any game or abandon any game. Any decision to curtail the number of ends to be played shall be made before the commencement of any game, and such decision shall only be due to or on the grounds of shortage of time to complete a programme.

Team members should be wearing matching KBGC uniform. Unless with prior approval from BC / ABC, Cream or white trousers/skirts shall be worn. Belts will be white or cream – not black. Proper bowling shoes, in white or brown should be worn.

The game shall be conducted in accordance with the "Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark Second Edition" of World Bowls.

The competition is a (3) bowls pairs in a format of round-robin in the first round. All nine ends of the two sets should be played to complete the game. Two points will be awarded for a set win and one point for a tie. An additional 2 points will also be awarded to the team with the most aggregate shots after the two sets. If the aggregate shots are tied, each team will be awarded 1 point. The team with the highest score would win the game of each group and enter to the Final. During the Final an additional three ends will be played when the set are tied.

1. Before start of play or on resumption of an unfinished game, not more than one trial end each way shall be played, with two bowls each.
2. No visit to the head after the skip delivered the 2nd bowl.
3. Burn end respot centre point.
4. All bowlers are required to arrive for the game before the scheduled date and time. Should any bowler(s) not turn up by the specified competition time, the team will forfeit the game to the opposition, with a score of losing two sets and shots difference of minus nine.
5. In the round-robin stage, all nine ends of the two sets should be played to complete the game. Two points will be awarded for a set win and one point for a tie. An additional 2 points will also be awarded to the team with the most aggregate shots after the two sets. If the aggregate shot are tied, each team will be awarded 1 point.

A handwritten signature in black ink is written over a circular blue stamp. The stamp contains the text 'KUALA LUMPUR BOWLING CLUB' around the perimeter.

6. In the first set, the opposing teams should toss a coin before the start of the game, the winner of the toss should have the options to, either place the mat, and then deliver the jack and the first bowl, or tell the opponent to place the mat, and deliver the jack and the first bowl. The winning team of first set should deliver the jack and the first bowl in the first end of the second set. If the first set is a draw, the team of the last scoring end in that set should place the mat and then deliver the jack and the first bowl. Before the start of the first end of a tie-breaker, the opposing teams should toss a coin and the winner of the toss has options as described above.
7. When the points are equal, the set difference shall decide the teams for the knock-out stage.
8. In the event of equality in point 8 above, the result of the game played between the two teams shall decide the winner.
9. Section winners shall be decided on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a tie. The top team will be qualified for the final.
10. If equality still exists after point 9, then the following shall determine the qualifiers:
 - a) Total shots for;
 - b) If still equal, the most ends won;
 - c) If still equal, the toss of a coin will decide the winner.
11. In the Final Day, the event of a tie after the two sets has been completed, three extra ends shall be played and the result will be decided by the number of shots accumulated. Should there be a tie after the three ends, an extra end will be played to decide the winner.

BC / ABC reserves the right to disqualify from the tournament any participant for misconduct or non-compliance with these tournament rules and update all the rules of this tournament.
